



MARION'S CAMP at LAKE SINGLETARY

SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK DURING LIFEGUARD OFF-DUTY HOURS

DAY OR SEASON PASSES ARE REQUIRED AND MUST BE SHOWN AT TIME OF ADMISSION TO THE BEACH

- No Swimming outside of the designated area
- No Jumping off the dock
- No Climbing on rocks – they get slippery
- No Throwing sand, dirt or rocks
- No Smoking, Vaping or Alcoholic beverages
- No Glass Bottles
- No Littering - please carry out what you bring in
- No Boating, fishing or scuba diving
- No Open fires
- No Horseplay, foul language or crude behavior
- No Pets of any sort
- No Fishing from beach or dock
- No ATVs or dirt bikes
- No Access to the beach from water by any type of motorized watercraft
- No Swimming when lightning or thunder is detected including a 15-minute period after the last sign of either

- Children 14 years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult
 - Use of rafts and games such as Frisbee or other wide range activities are permitted with the discretion of the beach staff.

- Park at your own risk and during posted hours
 - Do not park anywhere on Tuttle Road
 - Vehicles must leave promptly at the close of the beach
 - Sanctions include ticketing, towing and revocation of parking/beach privileges
 - Admission to the beach shall be refused to all persons having a contagious or infectious disease or open wounds, including sunburns or unhealed abrasion.
 - Admission to the beach shall be refused to any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs or exhibiting erratic behavior.
