- I. Meeting Called to order : 3:35 p.m
- II. Review of Minutes
 - a. Lisa had computer issues, so minutes were not prepared. November and December will be reviewed in January
- III. Youth Services Report
 - a. From November 10 - December 12, 14 children's programs with 167 people in attendance.

V. Directors Report

- a. There were 6 programs with 18 attendees in November.
- b. Notary Public- Betsy gathering the signatures needed for application. preliminary policy written which Betsy will email you for your review before our next meeting.
- c. Flooring quotes: The verbal quote from Nu-England Services was \$500. The quote from Matt Burns was \$990.
- d. The Friends are going to purchase a cash register for the library. It will be set up to differentiate funds and that will streamline our money operations from the envelope system that we use now.
- e. The yearbooks have been digitized and are online. A new page was requested for our website from the provider under the 'Reference and Research' tab. Our physical yearbooks will be returned on Dec. 18.
- f. The Jan/Feb newsletter is online and back from the printers.
- g. The pay rate for the pages is going up to \$9./hr as of 1/1/15 with the increase of minimum wage. This was not built into this year's budget. It will additionally increase to \$10./hr as of 1/1/16. I have built this cost into next year's budget. We need to discuss the rate increase in light of the jumps, and the impact on other employees

Looking ahead:

Writing Group is set to start in January. Dates have been scheduled thus far for January and February.

We're trying some 'Monday Morning Movies' on the last Monday morning in January and February. We've moved the television into the back room and we'll set up theatre-style seating. The Friends are going to buy a popcorn machine.

- c. Planning and Design Grant-The needs committee will begin visiting other libraries to see new projects. Betsy made survey posters with input from the committee. They were displayed at the Simonian Center, the First Congregational Church, and the Library during Chain of Lights. The one at the Simonian Center remained up for a week through Breakfast with Santa. One is going to the Senior Center for a while.
- d. The next step is a longer survey, both online and in paper form.
- e. The account for the Building and Design Grant is now set up. The \$11,000 from State Aid is showing but the \$14,000 from the Holbrook Account won't show until the end of the month. (Supplementary paperwork is provided to show transmittal of funds.)
- f. Next Meetings tentatively scheduled for January 26th, 3:30, and February 23rd, 3:30.
